MH900e Fuel Tank Kit Parts List *And Installation Notes Addendum*

2	"Dash 117" buna o-ring	Fuel pass through plates
1	"Dash 213" buna o-ring	Electrical pass through plate
3	Hose clamp, screw, 17/16~1/2"	Fuel QD + spare
4	Hose clamp, spring, 7/16"	Fuel pump hoses
4	8x5x2.1mm spacers	Replacement for Ducati p/n 713.1.198.1A

Addendum to Install Notes:

- ?? With the airbox removed, route the crankcase breather hose pipe to the space under the seat adjacent to (but not touching) the exhaust pipe. It is acceptable practice to leave the breather pipe open to the atmosphere. Alternatively, this pipe can be extended and a small air filter fitted.
- ?? Before fitting the tank into your MH900e, fill it with gasoline to test for any leaks. It is not uncommon for debris at a junction to cause seepage. Over-tightening is also a frequent cause for leaks, so this tank is designed specifically to be compatible with all of the OEM parts.
- ?? The small metal spacers as used by Ducati between the fuel pump base plate and the fuel tank are required for use with the larger fuel tank. These spacers are part of the recall for OEM Ducati MH tanks and are Ducati part number 713.1.198.1A. Four are required. Ref: MH900e parts catalog, drawing 019, pages 48 and 49 of the PDF, http://www.ducati.com/docs_eng/service/parts/2002/catalogues/MH900e_Usa_-02.zip
